ORDER ON POLICY AND TRAINING SCOPE

INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF ALBERT WAYNE FREDERICKS, JR. INQUEST # 17IQ427069

Having reviewed and considered the briefing submitted by the parties, Administrator Spearman hereby enters this order regarding the policy and training scopes for this Inquest.
