Subject to and without waiving the objection, in regards to "Approach/Contact" training, the City did not locate any training modules specifically devoted to "Approach/Contact." SPD's Edged Weapon Response training includes verbal discussion and drills related to making contact with subjects from the confines of the patrol car. The City objects that any Edged Weapon Response training is irrelevant to the scope of this Inquest, and its inclusion would be prejudicial as its probative value is outweighed by the risk of confusion or undue delay. ER 403.

VOLUNTARY SUPPLETMENTAL PRODUCITON

Following Dr. Mazrim's August 15, 2022 email, the City performed another search for additional materials related to the autopsy. In that search, the Seattle Police Department located a CD containing the King County Medical Examiner's autopsy photographs. The CD was not part of the FIT file, and instead was located in a sealed envelope, which had not been opened, in evidence. The City is prepared to produce the CD, but without a protective agreement or order in place, the City
