① What was Ms. Lyles psychiatric (DSM-5) diagnosis?

- her behavior with knives, and language related to her children "morphing into wolves" suggests psychosis, though I am an ecologist not a psychiatrist

② what medications (anti-psychotic or other) was she taking as assessed on toxicology autopsy report?

③ had she recently discontinued any medicines, anti-psychotic or otherwise, as a consequence of her pregnancy - understanding that there were no illicit drugs or alcohol on the tox report.
