## INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF ALBERT WAYNE FREDERICKS, JR. # 17IQ427069

## STIPULATION REGARDING SEATTLE FIRE DEPARTMENT PARAMEDIC CARE

The following facts are stipulated by the parties hereto:

- Seattle Fire Department paramedics were called to the scene by Officer Oliverson while Mr. Fredericks was in the American Medical Response ("AMR") ambulance being cared for by emergency medical technicians ("EMTs") Timothy Ota and Patrick Hayes.
- Seattle Fire Department paramedics ("Paramedics") arrived on scene and took over CPR from EMT Ota and EMT Hayes at 23:48 (11:48 pm) on November 17, 2017.
- AMR EMTs informed the Paramedics that no shock was advised on the AED (Automated External Defibrillator).
- When the Paramedics took over care for Mr. Fredericks, he was "unc" [unconscious] and "unr" [unresponsive].
- 5. After Paramedics took over CPR from the AMR EMTs, the Paramedics performed a total of twelve (12) rounds of CPR on Mr. Fredericks.

- 6. Paramedics also performed various other emergency medical interventions, including but not limited to intubation and administering IV fluids, 3.75 mg of epinephrine, 75 milliequivalents of sodium bicarbonate, and 1 gram of calcium.
- Mr. Fredericks remained continuously in asystole (without a heartbeat) from the time Paramedics took over CPR until the time he was pronounced deceased at 0:21 hours (12:21 a.m.) on November 18, 2017.
- Paramedics consulted the Medic 1 doctor on call throughout the time they were performing CPR on Mr. Fredericks. At 00:21 (12:21 a.m.), the Paramedics ceased resuscitation efforts at the request of the Medic 1 doctor.
- 9. These facts were derived from the American Medical Response Patient Care Report and the Seattle Fire Department Patient Care Record pertaining to Mr. Fredericks, which have been marked and admitted as Exhibit 2 and Exhibit 60, respectively. The parties stipulate to the authenticity and admissibility of Exhibit 2 and Exhibit 60.
